2011 Export Information

Cylinder & Slide is happy to announce the implementation of our export program. We have partnered with Steven D. Herberth DBA Falcon Defense to be able to provide you with the importation of our products. Falcon Defense will provide the export licenses and shipping for our products. Each export license will \$500 and payable to Falcon Defense.

Attached is a copy of the DSP-83 that must be completed. Block 5 may say "See attached" if you have more items than will fit into the block on the form. Block 6 would be your import agent if you are using one. Block 8 is only completed if the articles are imported by a Government.

You must furnish me with two purchase orders. One is made out to Cylinder & Slide Inc. and the other is made out to Steven D. Herberth DBA Falcon Defense. This document must reflect the purchase price of each item and the total purchase price in US \$. This must match the purchase price shown on the DSP 83.

You must furnish a statement of end use/letter of intent. This document in most cases will state that you are the importer and intend to resell the products only within the borders of your country. It is a violation of US Law to sell the products outside of your country. Should you be discovered selling the products outside of your country you will be denied any further shipments and future licenses to export our products.

You must have a license to import the products from your government and an International Import Certificate. The International Import Certificate must be translated into English so you will furnish Falcon Defense with your original copy of your International Import Certificate as well as the English Translation. The Import license must be certified by a government official. All documents supplied must be the originals and cannot be returned. You may email a PDF of these two documents to Falcon Defense for review before you mail the certified import license and International Import Certificates. Remember the documents submitted cannot be returned.

You will be responsible for all shipping expenses. We will provide Falcon Defense with the information needed to allow them to give you an estimate on the shipping charges. You will pay the export shipping charges to Falcon Defense.

You will pay Cylinder & Slide the cost of goods plus the cost of shipping the goods to the freight forwarder that Falcon Defense specifies. All payments to Cylinder & Slide will

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be done by wire transfer of US \$ to our bank. You will be responsible for all wire transfer fees incurred. The normal wire transfer fee is \$50.

The general rule regarding the need for an export license for firearm parts is that if the firearm cannot be fired without the part that part requires an export license. Grips usually require an export license due to the cost involved. There may be restrictions placed on the type of parts that you are allowed to import by your country.

Export of complete firearms are available if your country will issue the importation documents and our State Department will allow the export of the firearm to your country. Falcon Defense will be able to provide us with the information of firearm export to your country.
